# Confirmation Service April 28, 2024 Immanuel Lutheran Church

Confirmands: Lily Birge, Hunter McKinney, Kade Welte, Braden Wheeler

**The Confirmands** are dressed in a White Robe, announcing they have been covered with the holiness of the Lord through His gift of Baptism. It is also a reminder they have been placed into Christ's death and resurrection, and given the victory over sin and death. The White Robe shows they are equally precious in the eyes of the Lord. When He looks down upon them He sees them as His own precious children: which He alone made worthy!

**The Confirmands** wear a Red Stole as a symbol of the price our Lord had to pay in order to cleanse them of their sins. The Red Stole gives the clear message: the Father had to give His own Son as the sacrifice so we could be forgiven. The Red Stole is a symbol of the sacrificial love of our Lord.

- P: Faith is a gift of the Almighty God, C: It is a gift given through His Grace alone
- P: Grace has been given to sinners. C: God's Grace is given freely to all who believe.
- P: God has given us His means, C: His means to bring His grace to us- His Sacraments.
- P: God has given us His grace in truth C: He has given us His Word and His Absolution.
- P: We are blessed with believing C: We are saved by Grace Alone
- P: We are blessed with hearing C: His Word Alone in His Holy Scriptures inspired by the Spirit.
- P: We are blessed with the gift of trusting C: It is through Faith Alone that we know our Lord and His eternal salvation.

Confession: C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord, have mercy upon us. Forgive us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

**Absolution:** Upon this your confession, I by virtue of my office as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
