Opening Prayer

P: He came as the Son of God	C: <i>He came as the Son of Man!</i>
P: He was the “Lamb of God”	C: <i>He is the “One and only Savior”</i>
P: He was the Physician and Healer	C: <i>He is the “I Am, Who I Am”</i>
P: He was the Messiah	C: <i>He is God in our Midst</i>
P: Our hope lies in Him alone	C: <i>He is the only Salvation for mankind!</i>

Psalmody: *Psalm 99: 1-5, 8 - 9*

P: The Lord reigns; let the people tremble **C:** *He was enthroned above the cheribim; let the earth quake!*

P: The Lord is great in Zion **C:** *He is exulted over all the peoples.*

P: Let them praise Your great and awesome name **C:** *Holy is He!*

P: The King in His might loves justice, You have established equity **C:** *You have established justice and righteousness in Jacob.*

P: Exult the Lord our God; **C:** *Worship at His footstool! Holy is He!*

P O Lord our God, You answered them **C:** *You were a forgiving God to them,*

P: But an avenger **C:** *Of their wrongdoings!*

P: Exult the Lord our God, and worship at His holy mountain; **C:** *For the Lord our God is Holy!*

ALL: *Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.*

Lessons:

O.T. Lesson: Exodus 3: 14 *And God said to Moses, “I Am Who I Am”, and He said, “This you shall say to the son of Israel, I Am has sent me to you.”*

Epistle Lesson: Hebrews 7:26 -28 *For it was fitting what we should have a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens; who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins, and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered for Himself. For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.*

Gospel Lesson: John 6: 67 – 69 *Simon Peter answered Him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.” “And we have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God.” And we have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God.”*
