P: I will listen to what God the Lord will say; C: He promises peace to His people, His saints—but let them not return to folly.

P: Surely His salvation is near those who fear Him, that His glory may dwell in our land. C: Love and faithful springs forth from the earth, righteousness and peace kiss each other.

O. T. Lesson: Isaiah 54: 8-10 "In overflowing anger for a moment I hid my face from you, but from everlasting love I will have compassion on you", says the Lord, your Redeemer. "This is like the days of Noah to me; as I swore that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so I have sworn that I will not be angry with you, and will not rebuke you For the mountain may depart and the hills be removed, but my steadfast love shall not depart from you, and my covenant of peace shall not be removed," says the Lord, who has compassion on you.

Epistle Lesson: Ephesians 2: 11-16 Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (which is done in the body by human hands)— remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, by setting aside in His flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in Himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility.

Gospel Lesson: (Please Rise) Matthew 2: 1-2 Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the King, behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, saying, "Where is He who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw His star when it rose and have come to worship Him,.
