P: He was the Messiah	C: He is God in our Midst
P: Our hope lies in Him alone	C: He is the only Salvation for mankind!

Psalmody: Psalm 100

P: Make a joyful noise to the Lord, **C:** *All the earth!*

P: Serve the Lord with gladness! **C:** *Come into His presence with singing!*

P: Know that the Lord, **C:** *He is God!*

P: It is He who made us and we are His; **C:** *We are His people, and the sheep of His pasture.*

P: Enter His gates with thanksgiving **C:** *And His courts with praise!*

P: Give thanks to Him **C:** *Bless His name!*

P: For the Lord is good; **C:** *His steadfast love endures forever.*

P: And His faithfulness **C:** *To all generations.*

ALL: *Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.*
