Opening Prayer

P: Our Lord lives! He is alive! He has defeated death! He has defeated Satan! He has defeated sin and every evil! He has declared victory on our behalf. He has Risen! He has renewed us all in His loving grace and Resurrection.

C: *He has Redeemed the world. He has paid the price for all sin. He has given us life, because He is alive! He has Risen! He has Risen Indeed! Our Lord and Redeemer Lives!*

Opening Hymn: "*I Know that My Redeemer Lives*!" 461 vs. 1-3

Invocation: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. C: Amen

P: Our Lord, the Messiah, has defeated death. C: *He has Risen! He has Risen indeed!*

P: Jesus rose under the blessing and will of His Father C: *He defeated death, hell, and Satan.*

P: He came into this world C: That we might have life, that we may have it abundantly!

P: He came to honor His Father C: He came to set us free from our sins and grant us life.

P: Jesus has Risen! He rose that we might have life **C**: *He rose that we would be His forever.*

P: Jesus is the Victor, He is the King, He is the only Savior C: *He is Lord of heaven and earth!* P: Our Lord and Christ has Risen! C: *He has Risen Indeed!*

Confession and Absolution:

C: Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Risen Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your Holy name. Amen.

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of the Risen Lord and Christ, and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

ALL: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Easter Collect: Almighty God, through Your only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ, You overcame death and opened to us the gate of everlasting life. You granted to us the eternal hope of salvation and made us Your own through Your gift of Baptism which placed us into Your own resurrection. We humbly pray that we may live before You in righteousness and purity forever; through the same Jesus Christ, our Risen Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. **C:** *Amen.*

P: We are forever in His grace. We are forever in His blessing! We are forever in the loving hands of the Father. We live in the hope that will never die! We live in the assurance of His promise! We live in the goodness of His kingdom.

C: We will never know death! We will never suffer the punishment of our sins! We will never be separated from the loving grace and mercy of our Lord!

Hymn: "Alleluia, Alleluia! Hearts to Heaven" 477

O. T. Lesson: Isaiah 25: 6-9 (His Complete Victory for Us!)

P: God His given us salvation through: His gift of grace, His gift of faith, and His gift of Holy Baptism. We are and will be forever His chosen people: through our Lord's resurrection. We have life. We have life abundantly. We have life forever!

C: We celebrate His gift to us in His "Rising from the Dead!" We celebrate His defeating sin, death, and Satan! We celebrate our eternal hope given because "He has Risen indeed!"

Epistle Lesson: I Corinthians 15: 1-11 (The Gospel is Proclaimed)

P: We are the holy people of God who are cherished by our Heavenly Father! We are the holy people of God who were purchased by our Lord's blood on the Cross! We are the holy people of God through the work and grace given us through the Holy Spirit!

C: We are His holy children. We are His heirs to His kingdom! We are His own body of believers bound in grace forever! We are the "Body of Christ", the Church of God on earth!

Gospel Lesson: Mark 16: 1-8 (The Angel Tells of Christ's Resurrection)

WHAT THE SCRIPTURES TEACH CONCERNING THE LORD'S SUPPER

In I Corinthians 11 the Holy Spirit led Paul to write, "This is my body" and "This cup is the new covenant in my blood" to explain the spiritual truth of the Supper: Christ is truly present in His body and blood in the bread and wine. This is a mystery, a Heavenly gift; one we can only understand in faith. Paul further says, "Therefore whoever eats the bread and drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord" and, "let a man examine himself...for he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly." There is no doubt from our Lord's Word, we are receiving His bedy and blood. The Father offers us forgiveness, unity of faith, strengthening of faith, etc.; it body and blood. is never our right, we approach His altar only by His invitation. If you are visiting we ask that you please speak with the Pastor before receiving the Lord's Supper. We strive to lovingly carry out our responsibility to ensure the supper remains a blessing for all, never a curse. May His richest blessing be upon you all.
