Opening Prayer

P: There was only one source of hope C: It was through the action of the only True Son!

P: God alone can redeem His people C: *He alone can pay the price for our sin!*

P: Paying for our sin could only be done C: If the perfect sacrifice was given on our behalf!

P: Jesus Christ is the One True Savior C: The One who brought salvation to those bound in sin.

- P: I call on you, O God, for You will answer me; C: Give ear to me and hear my prayer.
- P: Show the wonders of Your great love, **C:** *You who save by Your right hand those who take refuge in You from their foes.*
- P: Keep me as the apple of Your eye; C: *Hide me in the shadow of Your wings from the wicked who assail me, from my mortal enemies who surround me.*

ALL: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Collect: Almighty and everlasting God, You despise nothing You have made and You have willingly devised a Plan which depended entirely upon the Work of Your Son alone, help us gracious Lord to trust in You and place our hope in the One True Savior that You have sent into the world on our behalf; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God now and forever. **C**: *Amen*.

Hymn: *Tune 433 "God the Light of heaven!"*

Jesus is the Savior! Sent from God above. One who shed His own blood By His wondrous love.

God chose to give His Son As the One who'd die. He'd pay for all sinners With a final cry!

Jesus the true Savior! Chosen to proclaim, Hope to all the nations Through His sacred Name!

Humbly grant us wisdom Insight from Your Word Lead us with Your Spirit So Your truths are heard.

Lessons:

O. T. Lesson: Isaiah 49: 22-26 This is what the Sovereign LORD says: "See, I will beckon to the Gentiles, I will lift up my banner to the peoples; they will bring your sons in their arms and carry your daughters on their shoulders. Kings will be your foster fathers, and their queens your nursing mothers. They will bow down before you with their faces to the ground; they will lick the dust at your feet. Then you will know that I am the LORD; those who hope in me will not be disappointed."

Can plunder be taken from warriors, or captives be rescued from the fierce?

But this is what the LORD says: "Yes, captives will be taken from warriors, and plunder retrieved from the fierce; I will contend with those who contend with you, and your children I will save. I will make your oppressors eat their own flesh; they will be drunk on their own blood, as with wine. Then all mankind will know that I, the LORD, am your Savior, your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob."

Choir: "Lead Me to Calvary"

Gospel Lesson: John 4: 39-45 Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in Him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did." So when the Samaritans came to Him, they urged Him to stay with them, and He stayed two days. And because of His words many more became believers.

They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this Man really is the Savior of the world."

After the two days He left for Galilee. (Now Jesus Himself had pointed out that a prophet has no honor in his own country.) When He arrived in Galilee, the Galileans welcomed Him. They had seen all that He had done in Jerusalem at the Passover Festival, for they also had been there.
